Greetings Clans & Societies - thank you for thinking of us!

The Saline Celtic Festival will be held July 12-13, 2019 at Mill Pond Park overlooking the beautiful Saline River. The setting is charming, the folks are friendly and the atmosphere is festive! 2019 marks our 24th year and we continue to draw crowds from the entire Midwest and beyond.

This year, as in the past few years, the location of the Clan area will be near the center of the Festival activities surrounded by food vendors, merchants, main entertainment stage, athletics, etc. The past attending Clans have commented on how well they liked this location.

Each participating Clan/Society will receive two free Festival passes. You can pick up your passes at the ticket gate area during Festival weekend. Additional tickets can be purchased below by way of the registration form or, through our website: www.salineceltic.org. Children under 12 and active military are admitted free.

There is no parking on the Festival grounds or in the lower parking lot at Mill Pond Park during the Festival. There is a zone for unloading/loading near the ticket gate. Transportation of your equipment can be provided to and from the Clan area upon request. Parking is available in several designated lots around Saline with shuttle service to and from the Festival grounds. Directions and parking information can be found on our website.

Site set-up may begin on Friday or possibly earlier. In recent years, some activities have been starting Friday evening and all vehicles are requested to be off the grounds by 5:00pm - the start of the Friday activities.

Setup may start early Saturday morning, but vehicles must be off the grounds by 9:00am Saturday. Also, the Welcome Ceremony/Walk will take place at 10:00am Saturday.

In addition, the Festival does not provide tents for the Clan tent sites.

Further, the Saline Celtic Festival and/or the City of Saline cannot be held responsible for loss of personal articles brought to the Festival.

Further, Organization agrees that he/she bears the responsibility for any actions or negligence on the part of themselves, or their own employees/volunteers, which cause injury to anyone on the Festival grounds.

Further, the Saline Celtic Festival and/or the City of Saline cannot be held responsible for injury to any Organization or their own employees/volunteers who attend the Festival on their behalf.

Organization understands and acknowledges that the Saline Celtic Festival will be held regardless of weather conditions, and hereby agrees to perform as specified in this document.
